PRIMARY YEARS PROGRAMME

Our Elementary School caters to children from three to eleven years old and offers a curriculum that combines the best research and practice from a range of national systems and international schools. At the heart of the programme's philosophy is a commitment to structured, purposeful inquiry as the leading vehicle for learning.

Students are actively engaged in learning about issues and themes of universal significance. These are designed to produce students who reflect a learner profile of attitudes and learning all of which allows them to participate better in the world they will enter as adults. The PYP classroom is student-centred where students are encouraged and developed to be active learners and critical thinkers. Students also learn to take socially responsible action.



Students explore knowledge through inquiries into six trans-disciplinary themes of global significance, supported and balanced by six subject areas: Language; Social Studies; Mathematics; Arts; Science and Technology; Personal, Social and Physical Education. Students also have specialist lessons in Computers, Foreign Languages, Mother Tongue Language, Physical Education, Swimming, Library, Music and Art. In addition, we have a rich after school programme.



The Learner Profile provides a long-term vision of education that is relevant across all three IB programmes. It is a set of ideals that can inspire, motivate and focus the work of schools and teachers, uniting them in a common purpose. MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME

Grades 6-10 follow the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (MYP). It is a programme of international education designed to help students develop the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and skills necessary to participate actively and responsibly in a changing world.

This challenges and supports the intellectual and emotional development of middle school students. Learning how to learn and how to evaluate information critically is as important as learning facts. There is a well-balanced range of subjects in English, Languages, Humanities, Sciences, Mathematics, Arts, Technologies and Physical Education.

The MYP is expanding worldwide and is recognized in many countries. Students can transfer easily between international and local schools and the benefits from the programme include detailed assessment and rigorous academic standards. This makes ISPP an excellent choice for those moving on to the IB Diploma, as well as those moving to another international setting or back to their home counties.

The MYP has an international perspective and emphasizes cultural understanding, skills and processes, and the connections between areas of knowledge. Our students are actively involved in community service, sporting and cultural activities and inter-school exchanges. The ISPP Middle Years Programme is an excellent nurturing bridge between elementary and high school education.
