- ✓ making bamboo food parcels to feed to the bears
- ✓ tending tiger, elephant and primate enclosures
- ✓ walking elephants



You will also learn why the animals are at the rescue centre and things you can do to help prevent further animal suffering.

# Necessities

All across Asia bears are under threat. In Cambodia and surrounding countries the biggest threats they face include mutilation for bear paw soup, loss of habitat, and imprisonment in cages for bile farming.

This is a local trip. We will return to ISPP by 3 pm each day although there will be one day when we return by 5pm after experiencing feeding the bears.

You will **not** be in physical contact with any animals but you will be asked to sign an indemnity and release form from FTB and PTWRC before participating in any activities.
