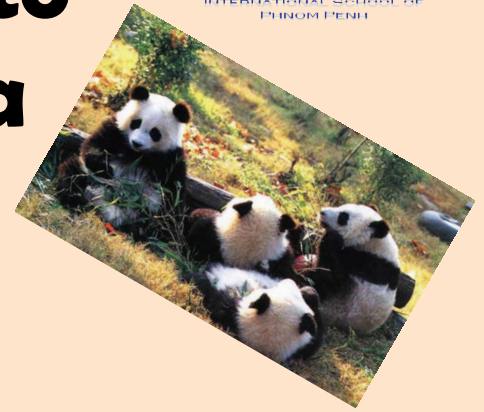


A cultural trip to Sichuan, China

The main objective for this overseas trip is for students to experience Chinese culture and visit some of the amazing places in Chengdu, Sichuan province in China. We will also be doing some fund raising for the Panda Sanctuaries and the victims at the 2008 Sichuan earthquake.

Trip highlights:

- Visit Le Shan Giant Buddha and Mount Emei in Chengdu, a Buddhist pilgrimage site
- Visit Sichuan Giant Panda Sanctuaries at Wolong, Mount Siguniang
- Visit Mount Qingcheng, a Taoist pilgrimage site
- Visit and provide meaningful service to a school in Wenchuan/Beichuan where the 2008 Sichuan earthquake had badly affected
- Experience the local culture and local cuisines

Target Grades:

The trip is open to grade levels 8 – 11. Students taking Mandarin as Language B will be given first priority

Cost:

Approximately \$1 100 USD based on a minimum enrolment.

Deposit of \$300 is required to secure your spot on the trip.
